Know When to Call for Help

If you're unsure if an animal needs help, ask yourself the following questions.

Is the animal showing signs of physical injury?
Is the animal immobile?
Is the animal showing signs of sickness?

If you answered YES to any of these questions, or if an animal has been hit by a car, attacked by a pet, or found in a trap, call the SWCC, or your local licensed wildlife rehabber.

Never Feed Wildlife

Feeding wildlife, no matter how small or seemingly helpless, can forever change an animal's relationship with humans and can be dangerous for both animals and people. Leaving water is okay.

Take Photos and Videos

This helps rescuers better evaluate the needs of the animal.
